

CJGA Manager of Tournament Operations Position Summary & Mission/Vision Information

Position Summary and Main Duties:

The Manager of Tournament Operations (MTO) will have a strong command of tournament management trends and best practices. The MTO will be expected to be highly visible and interactive throughout the event season. The MTO will also be professional in personal style, demeanour and presence and comfortable interacting with members, volunteers, host club staff, partners and CJGA staff.

As the face of the Association's tournament activities, the MTO manages the quality of the CJGA's onsite services to ensure the satisfaction of all stakeholders.

The MTO will lead the on-site operations including planning, goal setting and financial performance of each tournament. Experience and understanding of the game of golf, its history and traditions, event management experience in the golf or similar hospitality environment is required.

The MTO will be responsible for the following:

Leadership:

- Develop an effective working relationship with the Director of Operations (DOO), Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Board of Directors, and Staff.
- Collaborate with the DOO in the development of the CJGA's strategic and annual plans.
- Lead, mentor and build a strong team.
- Follow industry trends and best practices to develop strategies that assist the reputation.
- Be well-known and visible to all stakeholders.

Financial:

• Be fiscally responsible to ensure that the Association's tournaments are operated in an efficient and cost-effective manner.

- Provide timely, relevant, and accurate reporting.
- Assist the MTO with long-term financial planning.

Organizational Relationships:

- The MTO directly reports the DOO.
- Work in collaboration to assist in the administration and co-ordination of the Association's programs, tournaments and other related activities developed by the organization.

• Work in close relationship with the other CJGA professional staff and volunteers in the planning, implementation and management of administrative duties related to the daily operation of the national office.

Additional Responsibilities:

Work closely with the DOO to organize and implement all aspects of professionally run golf tournaments. These include:

- Oversee the operations of the tournament division within the CJGA.
- Managing, coordinating, and executing of all CJGA national championships.
- Maintain a strong level of knowledge of the official Rules of Golf within Canada.

As DOO, the role oversees the Tournament planning, coordination, and execution. Areas to be managed include:

Tournament Division:

• Manage, update, and bring forward new ideas of tournament policies & procedures, manage national order of merit, and manage and update the CJGA tournament manual.

Tournament Schedule:

 Assist the DOO in establishing the yearly tournament schedule with costs, booking events for tournament schedule, ensure each event operates within budget, solicit new venues, manage host venue contracts, update and maintain tournament schedule / information on website, manage partner pages, manage and service vehicles, manage event trophies and awards, manage seasonal tournament staff & provincial tournament directors, conduct bi-weekly calls to ensure timely communications with staff and independent contractors, conduct bi-weekly tournament operations meetings and distribute meeting minutes.

Tournament Operations

- Assist the DOO to ensure events are being conducted according to the CJGA tournament manual, ensure sponsor activations are prepared and executed to the highest standard and develop and execute operational plans for all CJGA events.
- Tournament operation responsibilities include golf course set-up and preparation, oncourse rules officiating, starting and scoring, post-round results and tee-times, public and media relations, maintaining inventory and tournament equipment levels including computers, printers, video and digital cameras, company vehicle and trailer to tournament sites. provide friendly, knowledgeable and efficient service to all stakeholders, work closely with volunteers and other staff in a professional manner.

International Competitions

 Assist the DOO to ensure qualifiers are conducted within the international event standards, coordinate international team selection criteria and assist with team selection, establish and coordinate all team international teams, team travel and team policies, establish and present tournament budgets.

• Assist the DOO with the development and execution of sponsorship programs.
