The Ledgeview Golf Club, located in Abbotsford BC, has just celebrated its 60th anniversary. With a unique and decorated history of developing some of Canadas top professionals, such as Adam Hadwin and Nick Taylor, Ledgeview is a challenging par 70 layout. Major changes have taken place over the past 3 years highlighted by the opening of a brand new 12,000 sqft clubhouse with a full service restaurant and large banquet space. In 2022 the Trans Mountain Expansion Project entered the Ledgeview property and provided the opportunity to make course improvements including renovations to 3 greens. Going forward Ledgeview is focused on being a host venue for major provincial and national championships which require optimal course conditions. 2024 will see Ledgeview as the host of the 122nd BC Amateur Championship.

The city of Abbotsford offers a great opportunity for an active lifestyle with reasonable affordability all while being a 1 hour drive from Vancouver. Abbotsford boasts its own International Airport, agricultural tourism, farm to table establishments, and the AHL Abbotsford Canucks (farm team for Vancouver Canucks).

Job Description

The successful individual will be an integral part of the maintenance team. Reporting directly to the Golf Course Superintendent, with over 30 years experience, the Equipment Technician is responsible for the general and emergency repair, scheduled preventative maintenance, parts inventory, and organized recording for various maintenance vehicles/equipment/reels. Ledgeview is committed to the continual investment in equipment upgrades and amenities for the maintenance team which already includes a hydraulic equipment/auto lift with 10,000 lb capacity.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Maintains the complete Golf Course Maintenance mechanical inventory.
- Establishes a complete preventative maintenance program for all machinery and equipment.
- Keeps thorough written records of all preventative and repair work done for all inventory.
- Integrates into a team environment and helps promote a positive work environment. Specific Tasks
- Inspects, adjusts, diagnoses, and repairs mechanical defects that arise.
- Establishes and performs required preventative maintenance in an organized and timely fashion.
- Grinds all reels, bedknives, and adjusts heights where applicable or replaces when necessary.
- Performs machining or welding when needed.
- Repair and maintenance of golf cart fleet directed by Superintendent when time allows. Qualifications
- Certified small engine mechanic and diesel hydraulic experience or 5 years equivalent shop experience under a qualified journeyman.
- Hydraulic repair experience essential
- Gas and electrical welding essential
- Experience with golf course equipment repair and maintenance including mowers and reels.
